Privacy Policy

Tommy Balogh Art values and respects the privacy of the people we deal with. Our company is committed to protecting your privacy and complying with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (**Privacy Act**) and other applicable privacy laws and regulations.

This Privacy Policy (**Policy**) describes how we collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information, and how we maintain the quality and security of your personal information.

What is personal information?

"Personal information" means any information or opinion, whether true or not, and whether recorded in a material form or not, about an identified individual or an individual who is reasonably identifiable. In general terms, this includes information or an opinion that personally identifies you either directly (e.g. your name) or indirectly.

What personal information do we collect?

The personal information we collect about you depends on the nature of your dealings with us or what you choose to share with us.

The personal information we collect about you may include:

- name;
- mailing or street address;
- email address:
- phone number
- payment information

You do not have to provide us with your personal information. Where possible, we will give you the option to interact with us anonymously or by using a pseudonym. However, if you choose to deal with us in this way or choose not to provide us with your personal information, we may not be able to provide you with our services or otherwise interact with you.

How do we collect your personal information?

We collect your personal information directly from you when you:

- interact with us over the phone;
- interact with us in person;
- interact with us online;
- attend a Tommy Balogh Art event;
- subscribe to our mailing list;
- make purchase on our website.

How do we use your personal information?

We use personal information for many purposes in connection with our services and functions, including, but not limited to, the following purposes:

- provide you with information or services that you request from us;
- deliver to you a personalised experience and service offering;
- improve the quality of the services we offer;
- internal administrative purposes;
- marketing and research purposes;

Disclosure of personal information to third parties

We may disclose your personal information to third parties in accordance with this Policy in circumstances where you would reasonably expect us to disclose your information. For example, we may disclose your personal information to third parties who provide other administrative and operational services to us in connection with our business, including financial institutions, security services providers, market research or feedback collection companies, IT service providers, payment processers and collectors, postage services.

Transfer of personal information overseas

Some of the third-party service providers we disclose personal information to may be based in or have servers located outside of Australia. Where we disclose your personal information to third parties overseas, we will take reasonable steps to ensure that data security and appropriate privacy practices are maintained. We will only disclose to overseas third parties if:

- you have given us your consent to disclose personal information to that third party; or
- we reasonably believe that:

- the overseas recipient is subject to a law or binding scheme that is, overall, substantially similar to the APPs; and
- o the law or binding scheme can be enforced; or
- the disclosure is required or authorised by an Australian law or court / tribunal order.

How do we protect your personal information?

Tommy Balogh Art will take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information that we hold about you is kept confidential and secure, including by:

- having a robust physical security of our records;
- taking measures to restrict access to only personnel who need that personal information to effectively
 provide services to you;
- having technological measures in place (for example, anti-virus software, fire walls).

Online activity

Website analytics

Our website uses analytics tools to help us better understand visitor traffic, so we can improve our services. Although this data is mostly anonymous, it is possible that under certain circumstances, we may connect it to you.

Retention of personal information

We will not keep your personal information for longer than we need to. In most cases, this means that we will only retain your personal information for the duration of your relationship with us unless we are required to retain your personal information to comply with applicable laws, for example record-keeping obligations.
